<b>In Brief:</b>	The programme aims to promote integrated prevention and constructive transformation of social conflicts, in the context of peace building, by means of a change of values and behaviors in several social strata, as well as in state structures and the civil society. The construction processes for change in social relationships will take place based on the transformation of underlying conflicts and emerging conflicts, which will enable to reduce violence, increase reconciliation and equality, and advance towards the fulfilment of the MDGs. Disputes and conflicts will be treated in two ways: as potential social change factors, and as events that can cause negative effects and may hinder the achievement of the MDGs. The programme will give priority to the repetition and extension of successful initiatives, complementing of efforts with organizations in the areas of interest and the implementation with organizations from the United Nations System

<b>Main Achievements:</b>	<p>Outcome 1: A draft law has been presented to fight against racism and all kinds of discrimination. An inter-institutional commission has been created, and a diagnosis and national plan on racism and discrimination has been started by the Vice-Ministry of Decolonization. Five legislative initiatives have been proposed to the executive and legislative organs.</p> <p>Outcome 2: The following things have been supported: the creation of the Legal Unit specializing in constitutional law in the Plurinational Assembly of Bolivia; the creation and presentation of four bills to the commissions of both chambers; inception phase for the strategic plan of the Ministry of Autonomy; strengthening of the institutions in the Mixed Autonomy Commission of the Plurinational Legislative Assembly.</p> <p>Outcome 3: Possible conflicts and stakeholders have been mapped; the INRA manual on land conflict resolution has been checked and given out</p>
